Reflection - Up and Alive

On being part of church:

Churches are communities of Christians, who often identify locally with the place where they gather to worship^(A). Churches link together in many different ways, from ecumenical groupings^(B) such as Churches Together in Penkridge, to global networks such as the Anglican Communion^(C). The Church of England is based around a parish structure divided into 42 dioceses^(D). Our parish, Acton Trussell with Bednall, has two centres of worship, St James and All Saints. Along with Coppenhall, Dunston, Levedale, Pillaton, and Stretton, we are part of the Penkridge Benefice^(E). The Bishop of Lichfield is responsible for the appointment of lay and ordained ministers to the Benefice to serve under the leadership of the Rector of St Michael's. Together, parishes across the Diocese of Lichfield contribute to the Diocese to cover the overall costs of this ministry^(F). The Diocese has some additional income from Glebe Land and investments which enables it to provide parishes with support such as advice on maintenance, social responsibility, and training^(G). The Church Commissioners meet the costs of Bishops, Archdeacons, the Dean and two Canons at the Cathedral and local parishes each has to meet the costs of maintaining their own buildings and surrounding grounds^(H).

To illustrate the above:

Growing up outside Glasgow, my family were part of St Mary's, our local Church of Scotland^(A). As a student I attended both the Anglican College Chapel and a Baptist church^(B). I was ordained deacon in the Church of Pakistan^(C) and served as a parish priest in the Diocese of Gloucester^(D). After we moved to Bednall, I resumed parish ministry part-time for 18 months, as priest-in-charge of Acton Trussell with Bednall - during which time, Delphine completed her curacy^(E,F). We came here because I had been appointed Diocesan Director of Transforming Communities, developing social responsibility in churches in and around Staffordshire, north Shropshire and the Black Country^(G). When I retired in 2021, I accepted the opportunity to serve in a voluntary capacity as a Canon at the Cathedral promoting the environment, social justice and community outreach^(H). Now I have retired again, the Bishop of Lichfield has given me permission to officiate, serving under the Rector of Penkridge in this group of parishes. As well as being part of the joint congregation of St James and All Saints, and leading worship twice a month, I look forward to working with the local community to raise funds for the reordering of All Saints, and see the building with its new facilities well-used by the wider community^(I).
