#### Reflection — Be still and know that I am God

For most of this week I have been wondering what to write in this reflection and the deadline is now upon me.

As I sat down to pray I opened an email from Tearfund in my inbox which had the heading that I have now chosen. It is from one of the Psalms - Psalm 46:10 to be precise and the whole verse reads "Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth."

I don't know about you but those are the words I need to hear and I hope that they will resonate with some of you.

We can be in no doubt at the moment that we live in a busy, changing and troubled world.

On the global scale it is impossible to escape the day by day news stories of war and destruction across much of the Middle East and in Ukraine and my heart goes out to those suffering so terribly and those working to bring hope. I pray that God will raise up peacemakers and that the senseless loss of life, unbearable pain of loss for so many and the utter devastation will stop.

It seems incomprehensible after two world wars in the last century that wars continue and with ever more destructive weapons. When will the world ever learn?

And yet, we cannot be without hope. Whatever is happening and however terrible it is, as Jesus often pointed out, we can be sure that God is with all who suffer. We can find that stillness and in time he will be exalted among the nations and in the earth.

At a personal level, I am just far too busy right now - I am in danger of being overwhelmed but then I am reminded that God is always with us - he sent Jesus into our world to show us that. I need to be still and know that he is God.

The previous verse of Psalm 46 begins "He makes wars to cease to the ends of the earth".

As we become still before God, knowing that ultimately he is in control, we can have that sure and certain hope to share with others.
