The logo comes in both portrait and landscape styles and takes its inspiration from the name of Acton Trussell as it appears in the Domesday Book of 1086. "Actone" is derived from the Anglo-Saxon "oak" (ac) and "town" (tun). The tree also emphasises the rural nature of the 3 villages.
